Subject Applications for Signs/Awnings

Pursuant to the request of your honorable body in relation to the above, please be advised that I have met with Inspectional Services Commissioner Cellucci and his staff in an effort to develop a more comprehensive process for these applications. As you know, certain signs/awnings are regulated by the Zoning Ordinance which in certain cases requires design review by the Community Development Department.

I am enclosing the attached applications which have now all been reviewed by the Inspectional Services Department, and where appropriate, by the Community Development Department:-

1. Petition of Dana Realty for an awning in front of the premises numbered 1384 Massachusetts Avenue, Cambridge. (Approval from Inspectional Services and abutters, design review not required).
2. Petition of Eduardo Catalano for an awning in front of the premises numbered 300 Franklin Street, Cambridge. (Approval from Inspectional Services Dept. and abuttor, design review not required).

1. Awning and canopies with no reading matter or advertisement are only required to obtain abutters approval.
2. Awning and canopies with reading matter or advertisement require abutters approval, zoning and building code review.

All staff assigned in the review process will be made aware of this procedure.
