IN CITY COUNCIL

COUNCILLOR ACKERMANN

ORDERED: That the Community Development Department be requested to assemble all parts of the Zoning Ordinance having to do with parking, including section 5.25, and immediately prepare for the consideration of the City Council and the Planning Board alternative revisions that:

- A. are consonant with the desire of the city to reduce automobile traffic within city limits;
- B. are consonant with the regulations of the Environmental Protection Agency; and
- C. protect residential and business neighborhoods from unsightly parking facilities or structures.

and be it further

ORDERED: That the Cambridge Redevelopment Authority confer with the Community Development Department in order to avoid the possibility of crippling future development plans and especially the Kendall Square Project.
