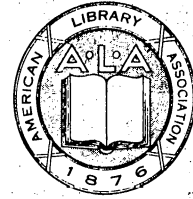

I transmit herewith communication from Joseph G. Sakey, Director of the Cambridge Public Libraries, requesting the following transfer in appropriations in the Library Department:


