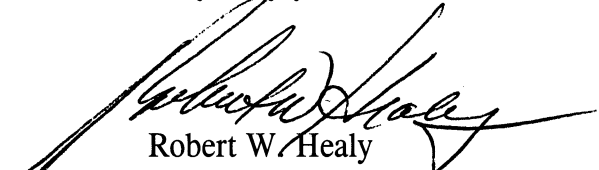
To The Honorable, The City Council:

I am hereby requesting the appropriation of a grant from the Massachusetts Water Resources Authority (MWRA) for \$10,994,000 to the Public Investment Fund Public Works Extraordinary Expenditures Account to provide funds for various sewer separation projects in the North Massachusetts Avenue area of the City. In July, 1996 the MWRA awarded the City a grant for \$12,500,000 for sewer separation projects. An appropriation of \$1,506,000 was made in FY97 for the first phase of the project. This request includes the remaining \$10,994,000 which will fund construction on Fresh Pond Parkway and Orchard Street in North Cambridge.

The Fresh Pond Parkway part of the project will provide separated and enhanced services to the general area of the community bordered by Concord Avenue, Huron Avenue, and Fresh Pond Parkway and is expected to be completed by the fall of 2000.

The Orchard Street project will provide separated sewer services to the immediate Orchard Street area which is part of the larger North Massachusetts Avenue project and is expected to be completed by the summer of 1999.
