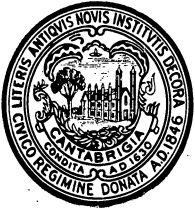

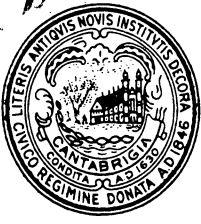

SUBJECT: New Street Skating Rink -- Site Selection, Access

DATE: December 15, 1972

Pursuant to the vote of the City Council on December 4, relative to the development of an MDC skating rink on New Street, the Planning & Development Dept. has taken the following action:

1. Supplied all available subsoil information to the MDC necessary for selection of a specific skating rink site, and attempted to arrange a working session with the MDC on site selection. The MDC has not yet completed its review of subsoil conditions prerequisite to site selection, however. Richard Lockhart is in frequent contact with John Frenning, Commissioner Sears' top aide at MDC.
2. Continued its analysis of the re-use potential of the former Dump site, with the skating rink at New Street as a given use.
3. Proceeded with a review of possible sources of funding for reconstruction of New Street to acceptable standards and for construction of a pedestrian bridge over the Boston & Maine Railroad. As a result of this review, an addendum has been made to the City's existing application outstanding for TOPICS (Traffic Operations Program to Improve Capacity and Safety) Federal funding, to include the pedestrian bridge. Several other promising Federal and State road construction aid programs are being explored for possible application to the New Street project. I will have a more definitive report on this shortly.

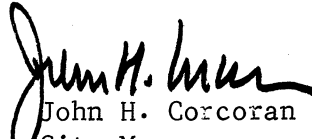
