In response to neighbors' expressed concern with problems of safety, both vehicular and pedestrian, at the intersection of Route 2 and Mt. Auburn Street, Cambridge, that the City Manager, with all due haste, arrange a meeting with M.D.C. Commissioner William J. Geary, the Director of Traffic for the City of Cambridge, and the knowledgeable officer from the appropriate M.D.C. Police Headquarters which has jurisdiction over the area in question. Additionally, that the City Manager file a report with the City Council within 30 days of the meeting, or as soon thereafter as is possible, in order that the problem may be resolved expeditiously.
