

To the Honorable, the City Council:

Attached please find copy of a memorandum from Kathy A. Spiegelman, Assistant City Manager for Community Development requesting that the City Council appropriate \$55,000 for the construction of 51 units of elderly housing at 2050 Massachusetts Avenue. The proceeds from the sale of the Russell School site have been designated for elderly housing development by the City Council.

The Cambridge Housing Authority has a commitment of \$2.3 million from EOCD (Ch. 667) for the development, has completed the citizen participation process, and has obtained permit approval from the Board of Zoning Appeal. The additional \$55,000 will enable CHA to go to bid in January, 1983.

Passage of the attached order is recommended.
