COUNCILLOR CLEM

WHEREAS: It is imperative that the City Council take whatever steps are required to insure that the City lives within the budget which the Council itself has adopted, therefore be it

ORDERED: That no order or resolve of the City Council which has a financial impact in excess of the adopted budget plan shall be adopted unless the following two conditions are met:

- 1) A specific dollar value must be assigned to the order or resolve in question.
- 2) A financial impact statement must first be prepared by the City Manager and sent to the City Council one week in advance of a City Council vote.
