WHEREAS: The recent increase in the number of acts of theft and robbery during the early morning hours in various apartments within the JFK Apartments, sometimes perpetrated against the same victims, has the residents of JFK Apartments fearful and anxious, particularly since there has appeared to be no indication of forced entry into the building; now therefore be it

ORDERED: That the City Manager request the Police Chief to advise as to what police investigations have revealed regarding the identity of suspect(s) in these crimes, and request the Executive Director of the Cambridge Housing Authority to advise what steps have been taken, will be taken and how soon, to increase security for residents at the JFK Apartments. And be it further

ORDERED: That the City Manager provide this requested information to this Council within one week.
