- WHEREAS: It has come to the attention of this City Council that a potential public health problem exists relative to sewers on Cambridge Street from Fifth Street to Ninth Street; and
- WHEREAS: Odors emanating from these sewers could be hazardous and are offensive to the people within this neighborhood; therefore be it
- ORDERED: That the City Manager be and hereby is requested to instruct the Commissioner of Public Works to take the appropriate steps to ensure that a comprehensive cleaning and fumigation program for the entire City; and be it further
- ORDERED: That within this program a method be established that would allow residents to phone or write in to the Public Works Department with complaints of this nature and that said program be well publicized.
