In reference to City Council order of March 28, 1955, to increase the lumens in the street lights on Museum Street, I am enclosing a rough sketch of the street lights at present on this street.

As you can see, the street is approximately 900 ft. in length, with seven lights, and receiving benefit from the light at the corner of Carver St., also from corner of Gorham St.

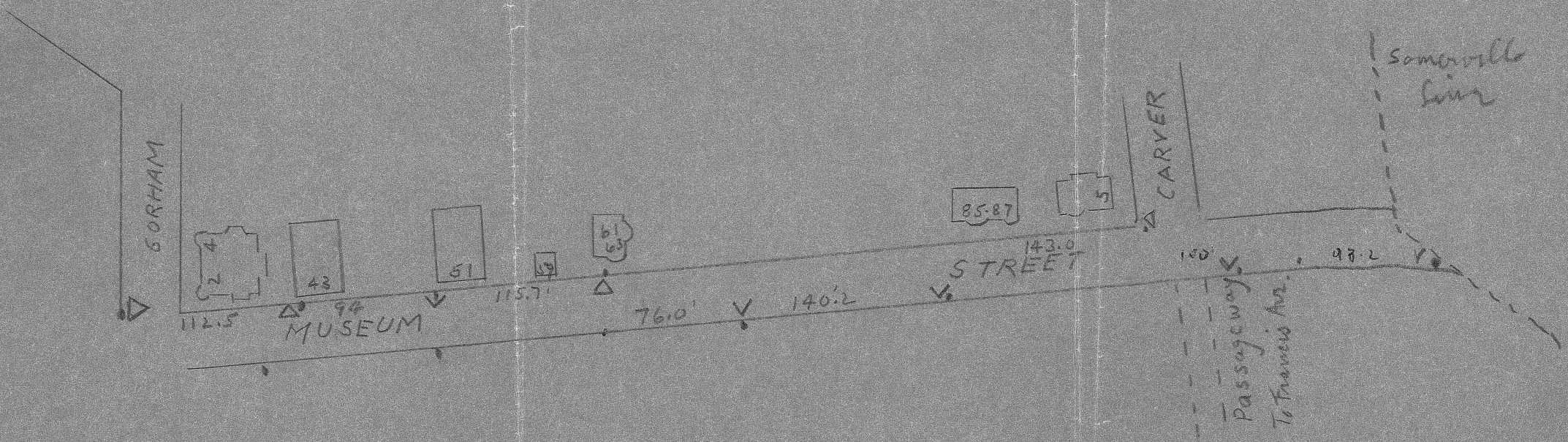
I believe this to be above the standards on this type of street, therefore I cannot recommend adding additional lights.


