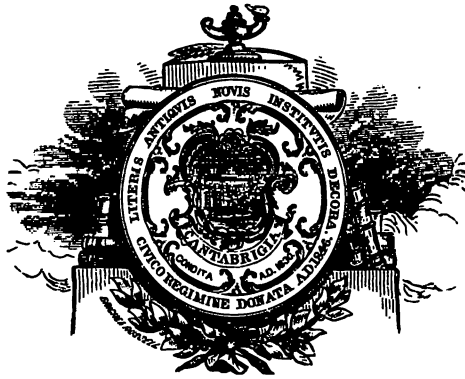

Resolved, That the public convenience and necessity require that

Brighton Street

*be widened and laid out fifty feet in width
between Mr. Auburn St. and Brighton Bridge*

by taking for this purpose certain parcels of land, as shown on a plan prepared by the City Engineer, and now before this Board.

Therefore, Ordered, that so much of the land on *both sides of*

Brighton Street

between

Mr. Auburn St. and Brighton Bridge

as is included between the *blue* lines shown on a plan of *Brighton Street*

~~Street~~, drawn by the City Engineer, dated *April 25, 1874* and now before this

Board, be taken for public use, and laid out as a public way and a part of said *Brighton*

Street.
