WHEREAS: Charles L. Stead, Principal at the Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr. School, has been denied the third recommendation required for tenure as Principal at the King School by the Cambridge School Department Administration; and

WHEREAS: Mr. Stead's personal character, his proven professional competence as a teacher and administrator, his commitment to the King School's students, families, teachers and other staff personnel over a period of years raise a question of uneasiness regarding the School Administration's failure to recommend him. In the spirit of the late Dr. King who labeled himself as a drum major for justice, we must assure that justice is done locally because, should justice be undone locally in this instance, such would be the worst injustice of all; now therefore be it

RESOLVED: That it is the sense of this Council that Charles L. Stead's performance as Principal at the King School is worthy of confidence and warrants a careful second look and reconsideration by the Superintendent of the Cambridge School Department; and be it further

RESOLVED: That the City Clerk be and hereby is requested to prepare certified copies of this resolution and transmit same immediately to the Superintendent of Schools, members of the Cambridge School Committee and Mr. Stead, respectively.
