Subject : 208 Land Use Planning

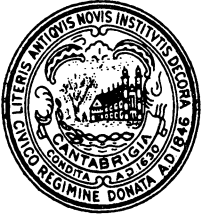

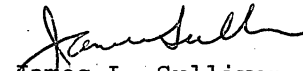
