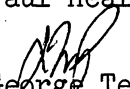

Dear Mr. Healey:

I have viewed the proposed location of a new driveway at 67 Brattle Street and the discontinuance of a driveway on Appian Way and recommend that the driveway petitions be approved for the following reasons.

1. The circulation of the parking lot would be safer.
2. Parkers using this lot would not have to circle the block to enter on Appian Way as they will now enter and leave from Brattle Street. This would remove some of the traffic circling in Harvard Square.
3. It would allow drivers to enter and leave this area with right turns in and right turns out with a better view of pedestrians thereby making it safer for all concerned.

These changes in design were made in cooperation with Harvard University and the Traffic and Parking Department.

The undersigned respectfully pray that a driveway for commercial use may be constructed and agrees to deposit with the City Treasurer the sum of seventy five (\$75.00) dollars, subject to the following conditions, to wit: In case the amount so deposited is in excess of the cost of the driveway, the difference shall be refunded by the City Treasurer, but in case the cost of the driveway exceeds that deposit, said deposit shall be applied as a credit to the bill and the balance shall be paid to the City Treasurer within thirty days from the receipt of the bill.
