WHEREAS: It has come to the attention of this City Council that there will be a celebration of the Charles River Basin Master Plan on May 14, 2002 beginning at 6:00 p.m. at Massachusetts Institute of Technology; and

WHEREAS: The Charles River Master Plan is the first comprehensive master plan in 60 years to guide the 8.5-mile, 90-year old Basin through the next century and create new layers of advocacy that will help ensure the park's future vitality in a time of diminished public resources; and

WHEREAS: This event will also launch the Historic Parkways Initiative, Memorial Drive Demonstration Project, a reconstruction of Memorial Drive from Fowler Street to the Longfellow Bridge that will expand open space along the river; and

WHEREAS: A healthy environment is an expressed community value in the City of Cambridge; now therefore be it

RESOLVED: That the City Council go on record thanking those involved in the development and implementation of the Charles River Master Plan and the Memorial Drive Demonstration Project; and be it further

RESOLVED: That the City Clerk be and hereby is requested to forward a suitably engrossed copy of this resolution to the Metropolitan District Commission on behalf of the entire City Council.
