- WHEREAS: He will begin his internship at Coney Island Hospital in Brooklyn, New York, in June, 1986; and
- WHEREAS: He was educated in Cambridge, having attended and graduated from St. Peter's Elementary School, Matignon High School, and Harvard University; and
- WHEREAS: He was one of nineteen medical students evacuated from St. George's University of Medicine in Granada by the United States Government, and subsequent thereto fulfilled his period of rotation in England; now therefore be it
- RESOLVED: That this City Council go on record extending its congratulations to Francis X. McCann, Jr., M. D., as he begins his career in the profession of healing, wishing him every good fortune as he uses his competence and compassion in the service of his fellow human beings; and be it further
- RESOLVED: That the City Clerk be and hereby is requested to forward a suitably engrossed copy of this resolution to Doctor Francis J. McCann on behalf of the entire City Council.
