ORDERED: That the City Manager be and hereby is requested to consult with the M.D.C. the feasibility of constructing a pedestrian overpass at the site connecting the Fresh Pond Shopping Mall and Heartland Drug in an effort to allow pedestrians on either side of the parkway to cross in safety.
