- WHEREAS: On May 1, 2002 Cambridge residents and people who work in the city are encouraged to walk to a nearby restaurant or park to enjoy their lunch as opposed to driving; and
- WHEREAS: Thirty minutes of moderate exercise, such as walking briskly, for ten minutes at a time, five days a week, can significantly improve one's health; now therefore be it
- RESOLVED: That the City Council go on record recognizing May 1, 2002 as National Walk to Lunch Day in Cambridge; and be it further
- RESOLVED: That the City Clerk be and hereby is requested to forward a suitably engrossed copy of this resolution to Cambridge Walks on behalf of the entire City Council.
