WHEREAS: The Washington and Columbia Streets area and in particular the Tot-Lot and basketball court nearby have deteriorated into an area which drunks frequent and drug - pushing flourishes; and

WHEREAS: The numerous criminal activities witnessed by neighborhood residents are frightening and intimidating and warrant a stronger police presence; now therefore be it

ORDERED: That the City Manager respectfully be requested to direct the Chief of Police to immediately increase the amount of police surveillance and patrols in the Washington and Columbia Streets area in order to allay resident fears and reduce crime in that section of Cambridge.
