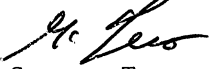

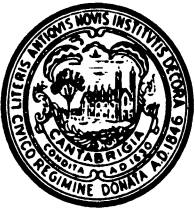
On February 23, 1987, the City submitted its review of the Draft E.I.R. for the Alewife Center Project to Mr. Hoyte, Secretary of Environmental Affairs. In this response both the Community Development Department and the Traffic Department proposed that additional traffic studies be conducted and included in the final E.I.R. for the project.

We suggested that there be no direct access to Alewife Brook Parkway from Whittemore Avenue and to determine what effect that would have on the Whittemore neighborhood. We recommended that there be no access to the project from Whittemore Avenue.

It is our opinion that access to and from Alewife Center should be via Alewife Brook Parkway only. We expect the final E.I.R. to study these options. After reviewing this document we will be able to determine what additional studies are required in order to safeguard the neighborhoods next to the Alewife Center development.
