- WHEREAS: The Nora Theatre Company and Underground Railway Theater are in a partnership, with the support of MIT and the City of Cambridge, to create Central Square Theater, a new state-of-the-art theatrical arts center to be located in Central Square, Cambridge; and
- WHEREAS: Central Square Theater will be the first permanent home for The Nora Theatre Company and Underground Railway Theater and productions and other programming are scheduled to commence in the new theater in early winter; and
- WHEREAS: Central Square Theater will be a vibrant hub of theatrical, educational and social activity, where artists and audience come together to create theater vital to the community; and
- WHEREAS: Central Square Theater will stimulate the local economy by attracting over 20,000 people to Cambridge to attend shows, take a child to a class, or participate in seminars; and
- WHEREAS: Central Square Theater will be holding Ground Breaking Ceremonies, which shall be open to the community and are free, on the 1st of May beginning at 5:15 PM and ending at 8:00 PM; and
- WHEREAS: At 5:15 there will be a Ground Breaking Ceremony located at 450 Massachusetts Avenue, the future site of Central Square Theater. At 6:00 a side-walk parade will commence leading Ground Breakers to a reception at YMCA, now therefore be it
- RESOLVED: That Tuesday the 1st of May in the year 2007 is declared "*Central Square Theater Day*" in the City of Cambridge to coincide with Central Square Theater Celebration.
