COUNCILLOR GRAHAM

- ORDERED: That the City Manager be and hereby is instructed to immediately direct the Chiefs of the Police and Fire Departments to survey the operation of the Charlesbank Laundry on Putnam Avenue with a view towards the enforcement of all laws, ordinances and regulations which are being violated in the conduct of the business at 153-157 Putnam Avenue with particular attention being directed to violations of the parking ban between the hour of 2 A.M. to 5 A.M., the noise and vibrations resulting from the operation of the machinery in the laundry at all hours of the night, the violation of parking ordinances by heavy trucks and the illegal parking on Putnam Avenue, and be it further
- ORDERED: That the City Manager be and hereby is requested to expedite the pending litigation in the Superior Court in order to restore peace to this neighborhood, and be it further
- ORDERED: That the City Manager instruct the Director of Traffic and Parking to report on any violation with particular reference to the issuance of appropriate permits for trucks at this location, and be it further
- ORDERED: That the City Manager be and hereby is requested to report back to this City Council within one week the action taken by the individual department heads pursuant to this order and to indicate when they surveyed the area and the time when the violations occurred.
