The North Cambridge Stabilization Committee has voted in favor of communicating its support of the City Manager's contract extension.

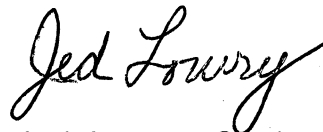
The City Manager has continually supported the concept of neighborhood involvement in the decision-making process with regard to community planning and development.
