January 26, 1987

- WHEREAS: In nearly every instance where development is taking place in the city, parking seems to be the main problem with both the residential and commercial property owners; and
- WHEREAS: When the City Manager's Committee, which was established to create a comprehensive plan for the North Massachusetts Corridor, was conducting its public hearings, many questions arose regarding parking; and
- WHEREAS: At that time a comprehensive study of parking in the entire City was suggested to answer some of these concerns by the Community Development to be done in the Fall of 1986; therefore, be it
- RESOLVED: That the City Manager request from the Community Development Department a report on whether any such study has been initiated and if it has not, whether one is planned for the immediate future, and report back to the City Council in two weeks.
