As a concerned Cambridge resident and parent, I am writing to request your attention to the lack of adequate sidewalk access to the Alma Boudreau Branch Library on Concord Avenue. My family utilizes service of that branch weekly and have experienced great difficulty crossing Concord Street to enter the library. Crosswalks at the corners of Huron Avenue and Walden Street are quite a distance away. Since Concord is a very busy street which includes MBTA bus routes, crossing Concord anywhere near the library entrance is dangerous and sometimes impossible.
