ORDERED:-

That His Honor the Mayor be requested, now that the Central City Building is about to be remodelled, to consider the advisability of establishing one central police station to be located in that building, and such necessary sub-stations to be maintained as information and complaint stations in various sections of the city, these sub-stations to be controlled from the central station and not to be officered with superior officers.
