WHEREAS:-

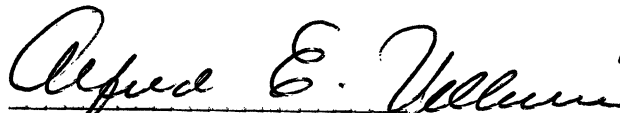
It is vitally important that the residents of Cambridge be fully informed about the Social Security programs available to them; now therefore be it
