- RESOLVED: That a suitably engrossed copy of this resolution be presented to her.

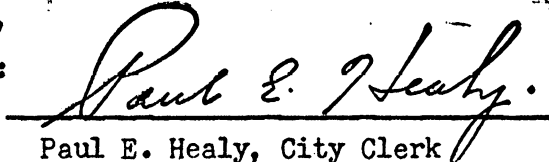
