ORDERED: That the City Council remind the Board of Overseers at Harvard College that the new library built on the Bennett Street M.B.T.A. Yards is a tax exempt unit of real estate property; and be it further

ORDERED: That it has been reported at City Hall that the library, known as the Charles Englehard Library, will soon lose its name - that it with the consent of the Englehard Family; and be it further

ORDERED: That this City Council recommend to the Board of Overseers at Harvard College that the library be named The Cantabrigia Library in honor of Cambridge taxpayers who pay the taxes on the library building.
