WHEREAS:

By reason of the strike in the packing factories a number of police officers are forced to be on duty many hours in excess of the number required, and

WHEREAS:

Justice demands that these officers should receive some remuneration for the services rendered (either from the concerns whose property they are protecting or from the city), it is

RESOLVED:

That His Honor the Mayor be and hereby is requested to confer with the officials of the concerns interested with a view to having the police officers on duty paid for the services rendered.
