We are writing in response to the schedule proposed on October 5, 1992, by the City Manager for implementation of the open space achieved by the Cambridgeport re-zoning. Although we generally support the proposal, we would like to suggest a change in the schedule which has the potential to advance the park's opening to Summer, 1992, rather than Winter, 1992.

Our proposal is as follows:

\*\*\*Mid November 1992: MIT provides the City with a draft of the proposed lease to transfer the land for City use

\*\*\*November through early Spring 1993: MIT, working with the City, complete site assessment and environmental procedures in accordance with federal and state regulations. Community Development Department conduct community planning and design process

\*\*\*Mid Spring 1993 MIT transfers cleaned, graded, and seeded land to City by long term lease

\*\*\*Late Spring to early Summer 1993 physical improvements to create park

\*\*\*Summer 1993 Park opens

This major new open space is much needed in Cambridgeport and was one of the three goals for the many residents who participated in the re-zoning effort. It was the first area of agreement among residents, business people, and MIT, during the negotiations which resulted in the re-zoning. We are seeking your full support in the speedy completion of this project which is very important to us and we are willing to help in any way that we can. Please do not hesitate to call on us.
