- WHEREAS: The Director of the Arts Council is paid \$28,645.00 Salary from the City budget and their offices are stationed in a City of Cambridge, Tax supported building on Inman Street which is supplied with telephones, utilities, janitorial services, etc., and
- WHEREAS: The Arts Council in their many and various arts projects are supplied with Police, Public Works, and help from other agencies of the City of Cambridge which costs many thousands of dollars to taxpayers, therefore be it,
- ORDERED: That the Director of the Arts Council and the Chairman of the Arts Council be invited to appear before a meeting of the City Council to discuss "the missing Great Seal of the City of Cambridge", on their stationary and also the present legal status of the Cambridge Arts Council.
