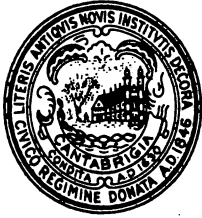



To the Honorable, the City Council:

Pursuant to Massachusetts General Laws, Chapter 41, Section 100G, any municipality may, with the approval of the City Council, authorize the expenditure of up to \$2,000.00 for the funeral of any firefighter or police officer who dies in the performance of his duties. While fighting a fire on Christmas Eve, 1975, John E. Cullinane suffered a fatal heart attack. The attached transfer will cover 90% of the cost of his funeral.

Passage of this order is recommended.
