City of Cambridge, as follows,

Of the amounts raised by taxation in the
year 1876 under the provisions of the fourth
section of the Ordinance in relation to
Sinking Funds, passed December 22, 1875, the
City Treasurer is authorized to pay to the
Board of Commissioners of the Sinking
Funds of the City a sum not exceeding
Seventy Five Thousand Dollars on the first
day of July 1876, and the remainder
of the amounts so raised on the thirtieth
day of November 1876,

Cambridge as follows.

Of the amounts raised by taxation in the year
1876 under the provisions of the fourth section
of the "Ordinance in relation to Sinking Funds"
passed Dec. 22, 1875, the City Treasurer is
authorized to pay to the Board of Commission-
ers of the Sinking Funds of the City, a sum
not exceeding Seventyfive Thousand Dollars on
the first day of July 1876, and the remainder

of November 1876.
