COUNCILLOR WALSH

WHEREAS: Concern has been expressed about the excessive rate of speed with which motor vehicles travel along Blanchard Road during the peak of the morning and evening commute and its danger to pedestrians; now therefore be it

ORDERED: That the City Manager request both the Director of Traffic and Parking and the Acting Police Chief to assess the situation and determine whether installation of some signs calling for "SLOW" and/or beefed up selective enforcement of the existing speed limit can be initiated so as to respond to the risk as soon as possible; and be it further

ORDERED: That the City Manager report back to the City Council on this matter at his early convenience.
