- WHEREAS: The future Priest attended Saint Augustine's Grammar School and graduated from South Boston High in 1928, and
- WHEREAS: Father Barry entered the Seminary in 1935 and was a graduate of Boston College in 1937 culminating in his Ordination on May 1, 1941, and
- WHEREAS: Reverend Barry was appointed First Assistant Pastor of Saint Thomas Moore in Braintree serving from 1941 to 1945, and
- WHEREAS: Father Barry began his duties at Saint John the Evangelist in 1945 to 1965 playing a key role in the rebuilding of the Main Church after the 1956 fire, and
- WHEREAS: Father Barry became Pastor of Saint Mary's of the Angel in Roxbury from 1966 to 1968 then returned to Saint John the Evangelist in 1968 as Pastor, and
- WHEREAS: Father Barry is Past State Chaplain of the Junior Catholic Daughters and Director of Saint John's School, and
- WHEREAS: Father Barry will now become Senior Priest in residence at Holy Family in Rockland, now therefore be it
- RESOLVED: That this City Council go on record extending its thanks and best wishes to Father Barry for his past accomplishments and future endeavors, and be it further
- RESOLVED: That the City Clerk be and hereby is requested to forward a suitably engrossed copy of this resolution to Father Barry on behalf of the entire City Council,

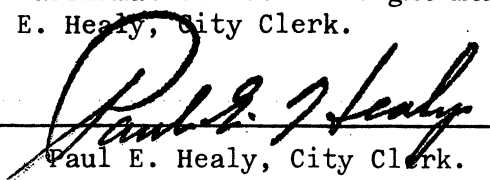
