Dr. Manuel F. Kaufman, an internist who practiced in Brookline for more than 50 years, died of complications of Parkinson's disease yesterday in Beth Israel Deaconess Medical Center in Boston. He was 89.

Dr. Kaufman was born in Boston. He graduated from Tufts University in 1933, and from its medical school in 1938.

An expert in cardiopulmonary disease, Dr. Kaufman was affiliated with Lahey Clinic and Beth Israel Deaconess Medical Center, and was medical director of the Parker Hill Medical Center.

He leaves his wife, Marcia (Glazer); and a son, Mark, of Newton.

Carl Johnson, 81, was bank officer
