The City of Cambridge Traffic and Parking Department is now in the process of training ten (10) Parking Control Officers to enforce all the parking rules and regulations in the City.

Although these officers will be used primarily in the Resident Sticker Areas, they will be concentrating their energies on the most serious parking violations such as drivers parking at hydrants, in crosswalks, in bus stops, double parking and parking too close to intersections.

I am warning all drivers who park in the City of Cambridge that the Parking Control Officers will be tagging every motor vehicle that is in violation and no vehicle will be exempt from these regulations.
