According to Victor Anthony,---a Cambridge born and raised homeless person, whose two brothers forced the sale of his grandparents/parents Cambridge home,---an alleged gay homeless person (male) named Ricco, who is estranged from his fairly well-to-do family and sister in Framingham: has occupied and squatted in a vacant large wooden house at 4 Arrow Street, Harvard Square, Cambridge, MA recently, and has apparently filched a lock from somewhere and has installed it thereon its front door, thus evicting Victor Anthony, who has been allegedly previously squatting in this house, perhaps for as long as a year or so.

Now, if this house is for sale, without any liens thereto, and without any big unpaid real estate taxes: if anyone should have squatters' rights to it, it should be Victor Anthony.

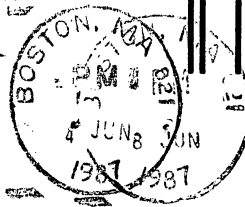
However, better still, if the Harvard College Phillips Brooks House Association could somehow bid on this house and acquire it for OneDollar or for a small amount of money within its means, with or without the help of Harvard College and the Harvard Corporation, as well as the City of Cambridge: a Phillips Brooks House HUNGRY-HOMELESS INSTITUTE could be established therein,---with a ban on all alcohol, drugs, tobacco, hanky-panky, violence, swearing, fighting, etc, and with the express purpose of housing only select homeless who could be fed and educated at Harvard for up to a year or so, with the end goal being to re-integrate them into human society in a mutually constructive, beneficial manner. This would mean no bums or hoboes,--only good people willing to accept Harvard -PBR control and guidance en proceesse. The endowment in time might come from publication of my 1000 poems in 11 sections, and about 150 each in HARVARDIANA (Harvard-PBR poems) and KAN-AFRIKANA (see PBR).

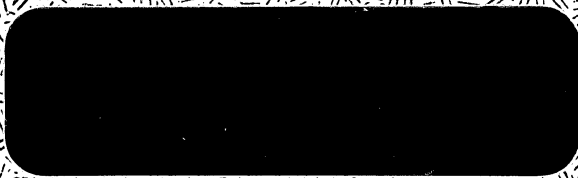
