Dear Mr. Dana:

The City of Cambridge is planning to install pedestrian controlled traffic signals on Concord Avenue, at the entrance to the Cambridge Sanatorium, 799 Concord Ave.

The Massachusetts State Dept. of Public Works designates the exact location of these signals, and they have pointed out that the bus when stopped at the present location will interfere with the view of other motorists with these lights.

I therefore request that you move the bus stop on the outbound side from the present location, approximately 30 ft. toward Blanchard Rd. and on the in-bound side approximately 60 ft. from its present location, toward Harvard Square.

I am asking the City Council to approve these new locations.

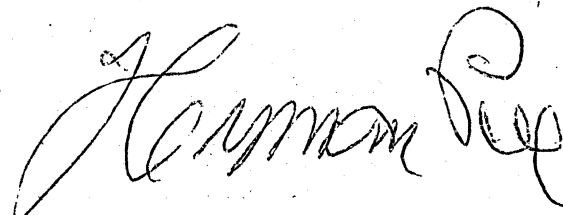
