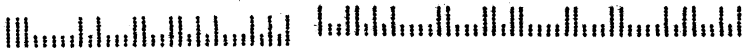
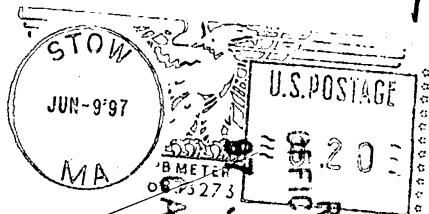

Important Notice for Municipal Officials

On Thursday June 26, 1997 the Underground Storage Tank (UST) Petroleum Product Cleanup Fund will hold a public hearing at 1:00 PM at 1 Ashburton Place 21st Floor Conference Room 3, Boston, MA. The purpose of the public hearing is to discuss proposed changes to 503 CMR 2.00 REGULATIONS IMPLEMENTING MASSACHUSETTS GENERAL LAWS CHAPTER 21J and 503 CMR 3.00 GRANT PROGRAM FOR CITIES AND TOWNS MASSACHUSETTS GENERAL LAWS CHAPTER 21J AND CHAPTER 148 SECTION 37A. The proposed changes to 503 CMR 2.00 would provide additional opportunities for private facility owners/operators to gain access to the petroleum product cleanup fund who 1) missed the April 3, 1995 deadline to file an application for certificate of compliance and/or 2) filed an untimely application for eligibility. The proposed changes to 503 CMR 3.00 make certain changes to the City and Town Municipal Grant Program which reimburses Cities and Towns for removal and replacement costs of UST's. If you are unable to attend the public hearing and would like to submit written testimony regarding the proposed regulation changes, you must do so by no later than July 11, 1997. Written testimony shall be sent to the Chairman of the UST Board at the address on the reverse side of this postcard.

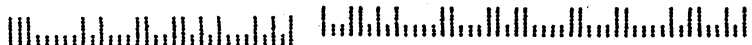
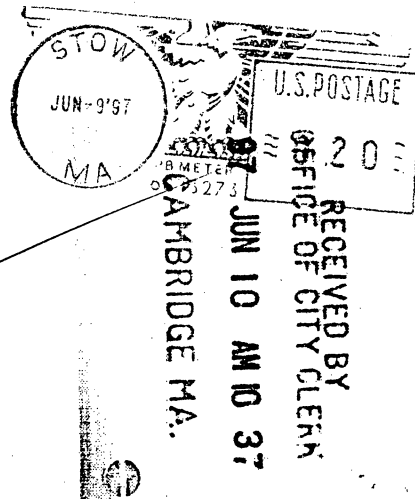
