An Ordinance
in further addition to the Ordinance in re-
lation to the Fire Department.

Be it ordained by the City Council of the
City of Cambridge, as follows:-

Sect. 1. The Ordinance in relation to the
Fire Department is amended in the first-
clause of Section thirty-ninth, by striking
out the words, "and nine Hoses", and in-
serting the words, "Driver of Horse Carriage, and
eight Hoses".

Sect. 2. Said Ordinance is further amended
by striking out the forty-third section thereof and
inserting the following, as

Sect. 43. The Driver of each Steam Engine
Company and the Driver of the Horse Carriage
shall drive, and have the charge of the
horses of the Engine and Horse Carriage, re-
spectively, and have the same at all times
ready for immediate use, and the stables

kept neat and clean. They shall also assist the Engineer in keeping the house and apparatus clean, and they, and the Engineer shall perform such other duties as may be required of them by the Chief Engineer.
