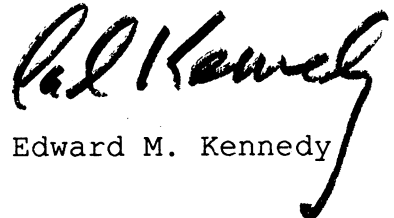
Dear Ms. Drury:
