WHEREAS: He will speak at 7:00 p.m. on "Brazil: People's Victory and the Road Ahead" at the Cambridge YWCA Silva Room, 7 Temple Street; and

WHEREAS: On October 27, 2002 the overwhelming majority of Brazilians awarded Workers Party (PT) candidate Luiz Inacio da Silva, known as Lula, a resounding victory in the nation's presidential elections; and

WHEREAS: Luis Fernandes, who is a political scientist and activist and a member of the Central Committee and the International Relations Commission of the Communist Party of Brazil (CPdoB), will address the impact and significance of Lula's victory and opposition to the Free Trade of the Americas Agreement (FTAA); now therefore be it
