WHEREAS: John O'Brien, the CEO of the Cambridge Hospital has publicly stated that the present Hospital facilities do not comply with zoning setbacks and that the Hospital intends to seek relief; and

WHEREAS: This situation has not been generally known before Mr. O'Brien's recent statement; and

WHEREAS: The Building Department of this City must have issued permits in order to allow the construction of the present Hospital to take place; now therefore be it

ORDERED: That the City Manager be and hereby is requested to provide the City Council with a detailed written communication informing this Council how the present Hospital could have been built if it did not comply with zoning setbacks and to further advise the Council of any other zoning violations that now exist with the present Hospital. Further, that the City Manager be requested to report back to the City Council within two weeks with a written report.
