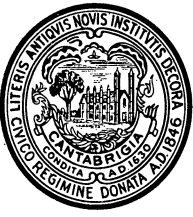


Dear Dr. Curtis:

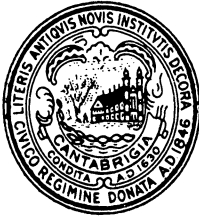


