Proposed Facilities Combined Sewer Overflows

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Ans'd.....

As part of its mandate to clean up Boston Harbor, the MWRA is designing a system of storage tunnels and pumping stations to control the pollution caused by combined sewer overflows (CSOs). A CSO is a pipe in a sewer system that allows wastewater and stormwater to overflow raw sewage into a river or the ocean during rainstorms.

Boston, Cambridge, Somerville and Chelsea have CSOs which cause many of the water quality problems in Boston Harbor and rivers such as the Charles, Mystic and Neponset.

Although the MWRA's planned project will help restore recreational use of these waterways as well as protect threatened marine life, **these neighborhoods will be affected by certain construction impacts.**

In order to explain this CSO project to you and to hear your reaction to our proposals, the MWRA encourages you to attend a meeting to be held on:

A draft Facilities Plan and Environmental Impact Report will be submitted in late December 1989, as part of a court-ordered schedule. The public will have an opportunity at that time to comment on the proposed plan, which is why we feel it is important for you to attend the December 7 meeting and to learn as much as possible now about the CSO problem and the possible solutions that the MWRA is considering. We want to work with you as we develop our plans so that we can address your concerns in the most effective way.
