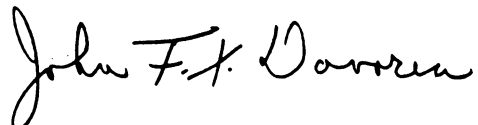

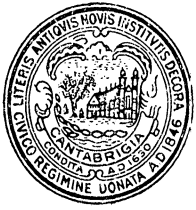

Pursuant to a communication from the Secretary of State re: "National Mime Theatre Inc.," I made an investigation.

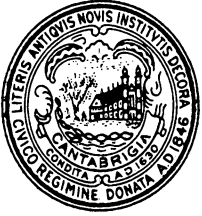
