The City is mounting a comprehensive sewer program that requires cutting open the streets in order to gain access to the main lines, and

WHEREAS:

Once the streets are open, it is much easier to replace the lateral service lines into homes with larger pipes that provide families with better water pressure, and

WHEREAS:

Better service lines are good for the homeowner and tenants as well as being good for a city that is stressing housing rehabilitation, therefore be it

ORDERED:

That the City Manager be and hereby is requested to abandon normal lateral line replacement charges for all property owners who are willing to make this change in concert with a planned and comprehensive sewer program, and be it further

ORDERED:

That the City Manager report back in 2 weeks with a response to this order that addresses the issues of price for service lines and comprehensive planning.
